COMMUNICATIONS:

OPEN FORUM:

Residents along Glen Road addressed the committee about proposed parking changes and discussed several opinions with signage alternatives. This matter will be discussed in detail later in the meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

MATTER RE: Proposed No Parking - Chelmsford Road Triangle – Follow Up – Keef

Chelmsford Road/12 Corners Plaza - have continued dialogue with Mike Tuohey. Will be modifying the location of a couple of the signs already in place along Chelmsford Road

MATTER RE: Corbett's Glen parking on Glen Road – Keef

The public hearing remains open and will resume at this week's TB meeting. Not all of the neighbors are in agreement as to what needs to be done. Tim Keef has spoken with a few of them and they are trying to arrive at some consensus themselves, but that hasn't happened yet.

MATTER RE: CSX Railroad Safety & Access – Clover Street – Cline

Contact has been established with CSX and a contact will try to be at the next meeting to discuss gate options, it appears that a portion of the access is within the Town of Brighton property and some private property.

MATTER RE: School Bus Complaint @ 2500 Elmwood Avenue – DiPonzio

County of Monroe has installed a “school bus stop ahead” sign in the westbound lane of Elmwood Avenue. Homeowner was at the meeting expressed here appreciation to the committee for the new signage.

MATTER RE: Roselawn Neighborhood Stop Sign Request - Rebecca Weber

Matter will be on Oct 24th TB meeting to set public hearing for installation of signs on intersecting side streets. See attached letter to Town Board for signage locations.

MATTER RE: Blossom Road @ Landing Road – Intersection Safety – Keef

Blossom and North Landing Road - we are looking at what additional signage we may be able to install along North Landing approaches to the intersection. We have sent a communication to NYSDOT to evaluate Blossom Road in the same manner, including considering installation of a traffic signal. No response at this time.

MATTER RE: Children at Play Signage – Kimbark Road - Heather Verbree.

Chief Henderson was to address Heather's concerns with respect to traffic and items raised in email. Committee to draft a letter to explain “children at play” signage request as it appears that this does not meet criteria set forth by the committee.
