OLD BUSINESS:

OPEN FORUM:

Hike for Habitat organize a hike on April 20th to go down to 12 corners and around the intersection and return along sidewalks and includes approximately 100 students. No street closures or police posts necessary for this event.

OLD BUSINESS:

MATTER RE: Proposed No Parking - Chelmsford Road Triangle – Keef / Tuohey

Questions about placement of signage on existing signage within the grass area. Spacing of signage to be consistent with posting standards. Staff to review spacing and posting to make these new signs enforceable.

MATTER RE: Corbett's Glen parking on Glen Road – Keef / DiPonzio

No new development but the parking season is approaching and continue to look for solutions

MATTER RE: Update Warren Avenue - Speed Calming Measures – DiPonzio /Keef

Public Works Committee will be doing a phased approach to improvements. Set public hearing to reduce the speed limit to 25 mph along streets Hibiscus Drive, Coral and Crandon Ways to have consistent speed limits within the residential neighborhood.

MATTER RE Brighton Special Events Update- DiPonzio / Cline

An established route along the Erie Canal and Meridian Park to reduce street closure and neighborhood impact. Discussion about staff with opening facilities but communications could be established to improve opening the restrooms early for events. An application fee will be established to cover associated costs.

MATTER RE: Comprehensive local ordinance for second hand transactions – Henderson

Follow up at Monroe County meeting tonight, Chief Henderson recommends that we continue with our local law to establish local control.
