COMMUNICATIONS:

OPEN FORUM

Posted weight limit signage has been identified as not enforceable signage and speed along Highland Avenue have been monitored by officer SMART. Mr. Gerek asked if the Town Board would be interested in adopting a local law to allow for the enforcement of a posted weight limit. Highland Avenue is a Town of Brighton Road but the City of Rochester also shares sections along the full length of this highway. Staff to collect some data, review laws and work with City of Rochester to put together a potential plan.

OLD BUSINESS:

MATTER RE: Proposed No Parking - Chelmsford Road Triangle – Keef / Tuohy

Tim Anderson and Capt. Cline reviewed two (2) locations for NO PARKING posting along this section of road. Public Works to take this up at next meeting and may bring this to a final conclusion with recommendation to Town Board.

MATTER RE: Corbett's Glen parking on Glen Road – Keef / DiPonzio

Received some correspondence but no clear consensus for any change. Potential change to parking ordinance to remove some already adopted language.

MATTER RE: Update Warren Avenue – Traffic Calming Measures – DiPonzio /Keef

Tim Keef stated we were taking a stepped approach to continue to address traffic calming measures with potential driver and neighborhood feedback about signage, education and enforcement.

MATTER RE: Brighton Special Events Update- DiPonzio / Cline

Brighton High School will be undergoing so renovations during the 4th of July and could impact the events including the 5K.

Canal Route is the preferred route for future races and Canal Authority will require an application and Town may adopt a fee schedule to offset set up and associated cost.

MATTER RE: Comprehensive local ordinance for second hand transactions – Henderson

Monroe County will not be enacting this type legislation and we will be reviewing our legislation to see if it does impact local business and if we will be moving ahead with our local adoption.

MATTER RE: Proposed Speed Limit Reductions Hibiscus Drive, Coral and Crandon Ways – Keef

Town Board passed the speed reduction and signs will be posted as soon as fabricated.

MATTER RE: Potential Contract or Bid for Board up Contractor Services – Roth

This mater will be brought to FASC to be given approval to solicit bids for emergency services for buildings and structures.

MATTER RE: Fire Hydrant Markings – Park at Allens Creek – Roth / MacAdam
