Met with the property owner and will be moving forward but waiting to get an update as to what the owner intends to do with the property.

MATTER RE: Pedestrian Crosswalk – Winton Road – Keef

Meeting with all interested parties to discuss findings and report back from Monroe County.

MATTER RE: Brooklawn Drive neighborhood traffic concerns – DiPonzio

Traffic enforcement continues and if residents wish to pursue other traffic calming measures the traffic data will be helpful.

Openings in fence to be determined if they are openings by school district or private residents. This is to determine if these openings can receive pedestrian traffic.

MATTER RE: Highland Ave Town of Brighton – Keef / Anderson

MCDOT responded and placed out traffic counters

Average 3500 (west) - 4300 (east) vehicles per day

Cube Truck - about 25 per day

Trailer (3 axle and greater) approximate less than 20

85% is at or under speed limit

Police Department is continued to monitor speed enforcement
