Upon review of letter and request the committee recommended that the applicant apply to the Zoning Board of Appeals for a Temporary and Revocable Permit for their event. If the Temporary and Revocable Permit is granted than the normal Town of Brighton – Fire Code Permit could be granted. As a footnote, the applicant was advised to use the same post card notification process so the area neighborhood are aware if the event is granted.
