


The Town of Brighton is working to transform a portion of the property at 1435 Westfall Road into a winter farmers market and multi-use facility. Objectives include developing a ***sustainable and adaptive*** master plan that is driven by community input and an understanding of the historical and natural resources of the site. The project aims for a synergy between ***innovative community agriculture*** and ***low-impact outdoor activity opportunities***. The Winter Farmers Market will be an important step toward a stronger and more sustainable regional food system.

Project considerations include the renovation of the existing buildings and the site improvements necessary to accommodate the current and future market vendors and visitors. Connectivity to existing community assets is paramount, and emphasis is being placed on renewable energy sources, sustainable building technologies, and environmental stewardship.

The Brighton Winter Farmers Market project will embrace the agricultural heritage of the site, and provide strategies for adaptive reuse that will serve the needs of Brighton residents for generations to come.
