OLD BUSINESS:

RE MATTER: Parking restrictions along South Winton Road at Middle School

School district has withdrawn the matter.

NEW BUSINESS:

RE MATTER: Request for speed humps / Traffic Calming – Bonnie Brea Avenue –

Lengthy discussion about lack of sidewalks and need for additional data collection on traffic counts and speed along Bonnie Brea Avenue. More data collection over next 2 weeks with an enforcement component followed by a meeting with Tim Keef and Chief Henderson to discuss data, enforcement and all traffic calming alternatives.

RE MATTER: New Commercial Carbon Monoxide Law

New law passed where every commercial structure has a carbon monoxide detector installed by the end of transition period of 6/27/2016. This is a large undertaking and will be working with building owners and area fire officials to provide education for a better understanding of the new legislation.
