**Town of Brighton Sewer Construction and Repair
RULES OF THE SEWER COMMISSION AND CONFINED SPACE REQUIREMENTS**

Please read before work begins:

- All sewer construction shall conform to the latest revisions of the Town standards and shall be subject to the inspection and approval of the Town of Brighton.
- Anyone connecting with or repairing sewers shall file an insurance certificate showing the amounts and types of coverage as determined by resolution of the Commission.
- The charge for this permit and subsequent inspections will be set by resolutions of the Commissioners, and reviewed periodically.
- No connections draining roof water, surface water from roads, lawns or other areas of impounded water into sanitary sewers shall be permitted.
- Wherever it is necessary to enter upon or excavate any highway Right-Of-Way, highway, or cut any pavement, curbing or sidewalk, permit(s) must be obtained from the appropriate agency (town, county or state).
- The Applicant, in making this application, acknowledges that the work site contains permit-required confined spaces, that entry to these spaces must be in complete accord with an O.S.H.A compliant confined space program, that he/she has been informed of the potential hazards of these spaces, and that he/she has been informed of the precautions used by the Town in entering these spaces.

In accordance with the requirements of the O.S.H.A Permit-Required Confined Space Standard 1910.146, this information is being made available to the Applicant so that they can take appropriate precautions to protect their employees during a Permit-Required Confined Space operation. The following is a list of permit space locations, their identified hazards, and precautions recommended by the Town:

If Town employees will be involved with entry into or near the permit space, the applicant will be so advised and will be required to coordinate entry operations with the contractor.
The Applicant is required to use his/her Confined Space Program for entry into confined spaces owned by the Town of Brighton.
The Applicant shall, at completion of the entry operation, inform the Sewer Construction Inspector in writing of any hazards confronted or created during their work in the Town’s permit space locations.
