Ceremonial Bon Fire Permit Application

In accordance with the Code of the Town of Brighton and the New York State Fire Prevention and Building Code, an operational permit is required to start, possess or maintain a ceremonial bon fire. All fire activities shall comply with the Fire Code of New York State and the codes adopted by the Town of Brighton.

The undersigned represents that this application for a permit as described herein will be in accordance with all ordinances of the Town of Brighton and the Fire and Building Code of New York State and that any plans or specifications submitted with this application are the plans or specifications relating to this permit and no other.

The location for **open burning** must be at least 50 feet from any structure, and provisions shall be made to prevent the fire from spreading to within 50 feet of any structure. (FCNYS 307.4)

A **bonfire** shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure. Conditions, which could cause a fire to spread within 25 feet of a structure, shall be eliminated prior to ignition. (FCNYS 307.4.1)

Open burning and bonfires shall be constantly attended until the fire is extinguished. A minimum of one portable fire extinguisher of a minimum 4-A rating or other on-site fire fighting equipment such as dirt/sand and shovel, water barrel, garden hose, or water truck must be available for immediate use. (FCNYS 307.5)

Fire must be extinguished by 10:00 p.m.

Burring material shall consist of dry wood only and may not include rubbish, garbage, trash, any yard waste, any materials made of or coated with rubber, plastic, leather or petroleum based materials and may not contain any flammable or combustible liquids.

NO OPEN BURNING OR BONFIRE SHALL COMMENCE WITHOUT A VALID PERMIT ISSUED BY OFFICE OF THE FIRE MARSHAL
