- Town Hall is **open on an appointment-only basis**. Visitors with appointments must wear masks & enter through the front or rear door of the Public Safety wing, as all other entrances remain closed. - [Brighton Memorial Library](#) is closed but curbside book pick-up is available. Call 784-5300.
- Brighton Police Department has restricted access for non-emergency issues. Call in advance at 784-5150.
- Town Court is partially open. Questions? Call 784-5152.

- Containerized & bulk yard debris is being picked up. Residents may also bring [yard debris](#) to the Highway Dept. at 1941 Elmwood Ave.

- The parking lot at Corbett's Glen Nature Park is now OPEN. But, "no parking" is posted along [surrounding streets](#).
- The Town pool is closed. Athletic Fields will open for low to moderate risk sports on July 6th. Basketball Courts remain closed as identified by NYS as a high risk activity.
