APPLICANTS SOUGHT FOR MEMBERSHIP ON BRIGHTON BOARDS

The Town of Brighton is seeking applicants interested in serving as volunteer members on the Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA) and Conservation Board. The ZBA plays an important role in the implementation of Town zoning regulations. The Board hears appeals from decisions made by the Building Inspector or other administrative officers in the enforcement of zoning regulations, and the granting of variances to zoning regulations. Members of the ZBA serve five-year terms and meet monthly on the first Wednesday at 7p.m.

The Conservation Board reviews property development proposals for such matters as drainage, landscaping and environmental protection. It considers environmental issues and concerns for site-plan approvals, open space development, woodlots, watercourses, etc., and advises the Planning Board regarding these actions. Members of the Conservation Board serve two-year terms and meet monthly on either the first or second Tuesday at 7:00 p.m.
