Brighton Adopts Volunteer Firefighters and Ambulance Workers Tax Exemption

The Brighton Town Board adopted a local law providing volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers a 10% town property tax exemption during their meeting of February 9, 2022. The exemption is for Brighton residents who are volunteer firefighters for the Brighton Fire District or Henrietta Fire District (which serves the western portion of Brighton), or volunteers with Brighton Volunteer Ambulance.

“This property tax exemption helps acknowledge the importance of the skilled work these volunteers provide. Our volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers play a key part in the town’s public safety, and we appreciate the time and effort they devote to helping keep Brighton safe. We also hope that this property tax exemption encourages more residents to join in this important volunteer effort,” said Supervisor William W. Moehle.
