Brighton Invites Input on Climate Action Plan

The Town of Brighton will host a virtual public workshop on the Town's Climate Action Plan on Tuesday, April 5 at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom. The public can participate in this interactive workshop by following the link available at townofbrighton.org/climate-action-plan. Participants will meet the project team, learn about climate action planning and the Town's proposed climate action plan process, and join an online brainstorming session.

The Climate Action Plan will identify greenhouse gas reduction goals for both Town facilities and the community at large, and will recommend actions for achieving those goals. Community engagement is an essential component of this project and stakeholders can learn more about the Plan and how to comment at townofbrighton.org/climate-action-plan.
