PAVEMENT REHABILITATION ALONG STATE ROUTES 590 AND 104 IN MONROE COUNTY TO BEGIN NEXT WEEK

June 30, 2022 (Rochester, NY) – The New York State Department of Transportation is advising motorists to expect overnight lane and ramp closures along State Route 590, between Blossom Road and Titus Avenue, and along State Route 104 from Culver Road to the Irondequoit Bay Bridge, in the towns of Brighton and Irondequoit, Monroe County, beginning Tuesday, July 5. The closures are necessary to facilitate a pavement resurfacing project and are expected to continue through November, weather permitting.

Both State Route 590 and State Route 104 will remain open to traffic during construction however motorists may need to follow posted detours during short-term ramp closures.

Motorists are reminded that fines are doubled for speeding in a work zone. In accordance with the Work Zone Safety Act of 2005, convictions of two or more speeding violations in a work zone could result in the suspension of an individual's driver's license.
